## Covid-19 Return to Sailing Phase 2 Use of Club Boats

From Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> July, club boats will be made available for members to **either use or pre-book**:

- Teras, Toppers and Optibats can be used without booking following the instructions below.
- Fevas and RS Quest must be pre-booked. **Contact for bookings are listed below.**

The following conditions must be met:

- Club members only, no guests
- Parents are responsible for their children at all times, on site and on the water.
- Sailors must be competent and physically able to sail, recover from a capsized or gear failure and get back to shore. It is the sailors or sailor's parents' responsibility to assess the conditions, and reduce the risk of needing to call the emergency services. **No normal rescue cover will be provided; RIBs are available for emergencies only.**
- Sailors/parents must be competent to rig the boat correctly and spot any problems before going afloat, as they would their own boat.
- The only exception to the above would be parents with youngsters in an Optibat, or Tera sailing alongside or on shore with the boat on the end of a long rope or sailing in a very limited area.
- **All club boats including the Grey RS Quest and Laser Picos must be fitted with a masthead float.**
- A sailing slot must be booked in the usual way – enter for example 'club Tera' / 'club Optibat' etc.



# Coronavirus Use of Club Boats

## Managing Boats and Kit

- Each boat to be used by one person only or a 'same household group' on each day
- A minimum of 72 hours must be left before a boat and its kit can be used again
- Fevas and RS Quests must be booked through the fleet co-ordinator **prior to booking** a sailing slot, the sailing slot can then be booked in the usual way. The kit is then managed in the same way as other club boats below.
- For Optibats, Teras and Toppers:
  - Report to OOD and explain you are using a club boat (should be recorded on their sailor lists).
  - Pick boat starting on LHS, note the number and inform OOD which boat you are using.
  - Collect kit from sail store / Optibat store – one person in store at any one time.
  - At the end of your sailing slot place all kit neatly on the floor of the training room – NOT back in the sail store.
- Any problems with the boat you use must be reported to the club dinghy bosun asap. Rob Henderson on 07876 069068.
- Currently the club has decided not to charge for the use of club boats. However, we ask you to consider making a donation to the club at the end of August so please keep a note of how often you use a club boat.
