

CVLSC Coronavirus Return to Sailing

Members Instructions in relation to Covid 27 January 2022

Please take time to familiarise yourself with these instructions before coming sailing.

General Overview

The instructions reflect the latest government rules and advice, and that also provided by our governing body, the RYA and Bristol Water.

Before travelling you should take account and abide by the latest government guidance on covid-19 and social distancing available [here](#). Member's resident in Wales should remember that they are subject to different rules.

As detailed in the club bye laws, it remains your responsibility to assess the conditions; sail within your limitations and minimise the risk of needing to call the emergency services. RIBs are available for emergencies only.

Who can come to the club?

Members may come to the club subject to the following:

- Any travel must be in accordance with the government guidelines.
- Guests are permitted subject to the payment of normal guest/boat fees

In and around the clubhouse:

All members are expected to be considerate and courteous of others. Please exercise common sense and good judgement to help avoid putting yourself and others at risk, taking account of the latest government advice and guidance.

Please use the hand sanitiser provided on entry to clubhouse areas and when using common equipment. Members are also advised to bring their own hand sanitiser for use e.g. at the entry gate and other general 'touch points' where the supply of hand sanitiser is prone to being removed/emptied

It is no longer mandatory to wear a face covering indoors and members should make their own decision as to what is appropriate taking account of their own circumstances and bearing in mind the latest government advice which suggests you continue to wear one in crowded and indoor spaces where you may come into contact with people you do not normally meet.

Please help the duty team ensure that the clubhouse spaces remain well ventilated by leaving doors and windows open, even though it may be cold

If we are hosting a large event, as an added precaution to help keep everyone safe we may ask you to undertake a Lateral Flow Test (LFT) before attending. This requirement will be notified to members by email through the periodic newsletter.
